



### 3 Minute Movie Rules

- Registration is required by all players in each team and entry fee must accompany registration form.
- Members of AOC Community Media pay a \$3.00 entry fee and non-members pay a \$9.00 entry fee.
- All crew members who use AOC Community Media equipment must sign an equipment liability form.
- Each crew must choose a producer who is required to sign a producer liability form.
- AOC Community Media will provide cameras to the first 12 teams that require use of them. No lighting kits, field monitors or any other production equipment will be issued to any participant by AOC.
- Use of personal production equipment is accepted.
- Registration is open to everyone.
- Players under the age of 18 must have an adult guardian sign the liability forms and the producer agreement.
- All entries are property of the creators and the creators will hold the copyright. It is up to each crew to assign ownership.
- AOC Community Media reserves the right to play any or all entries on any media of AOC's choice in whole or in part.
- Entries that are unable to play on AOC's projectors will be disqualified. Entries that are not submitted by 6 p.m. on the day of the closing party will be disqualified.
- All entries must be submitted on DVD unless otherwise specified.
- If any legal content is used, players will warrant that all material submitted is copyright appropriate.
- All independent entrants can be placed with teams.
- Each entry must contain the three plot points/props that are drawn during the opening kick-off party.
- Each entry will be given 3:30 (3 minutes and 30 seconds) total run time during the premiere party. Recommended use of time is 20 seconds for team color identification, 3 minutes of content and 10 seconds for credits. If the entry is longer than 3 minutes and 30 seconds the entry will only be played for the amount of time allotted.
- Each entry must contain credits, a title and a slug that identifies the team color. These will not be included in the total run time of 3 minutes. (please see rule for recommended use of time.)
- Registered players will vote on a winner at the closing party. Each crew member/player gets three votes. One vote may count towards their own entry. The two other votes must be given to other competing entries.
- Judging will be based on the interpretation and inclusion of plot points/props, time, technical achievement, originality, story-telling ability, adherence to rules and the judgment of voters.
